Hay and Ditch Mowing

Producers can once again take advantage of free hay in Saskatchewan's provincial highway ditches.

Hay can be salvaged any time during the spring or summer months. Before and including July 8, landowners or lessees nearest/adjacent to the ditch have the first option to cut or bale material, but after that day anyone can cut and bale without permission from the property-owner, as long as no salvage operations have already begun. It is recommended that participants contact their local ministry office to provide contact information and limits on where they are salvaging hay to avoid disputes.

Hay must be cut at a uniform height in ditches and bales must be placed at least eight metres away from the shoulder of the highway. Bales must be removed by August 8, otherwise they may be subject to removal and disposal by the ministry. After August 8, bales must be removed immediately following haying operations. The ministry may also remove and dispose of hay bales in locations deemed unsafe for drivers.



Single Stream Recycling

Bins are located at both Transfer Stations

Single-stream recycling is a system in which all Recycle materials – fiber, plastics, tin and aluminum – are placed, unsorted, in the Blue Recycle Container.

Tissue boxes
Plastic pill bottles

Kitchen

Milk jugs & cartons
Creamer cartons & bottles
Paper egg cartons
Soup, Vegetable Cans, etc.
Aluminum and tin cans
Pie tins
Plastic juice bottles
Juice cans
Yogurt containers
Salad dressing containers
Cereal boxes
Pizza boxes – unsoiled

Office paper
Catalogues, Phone books
Cardboard boxes
Scrap paper, sticky notes

Please do not put the following in the Recycle Bin:

Glass, Styrofoam, ceramics, light bulbs, soiled cardboard, hazardous chemical containers, scrap metal, car parts, plastic toys or household garbage.

TRANSFER STATIONS

The RM of Riverside pays a portion of the costs with the Town of Cabri and the Village of Pennant for garbage bins located at the former landfill sites within the municipality. We have a large 30 yard roll off recycle bin located at the Cabri Transfer Station NW 32-18-18W3M.

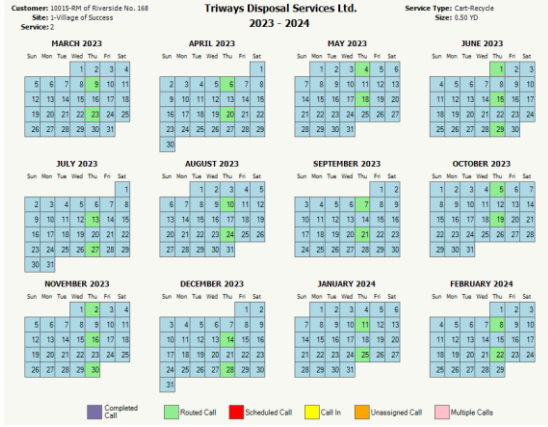
